THE FOLLOWING TEN LOTS ARE FROM THE ESTATE OF THE LATE CYRIL JOHN MARTIN. MARTIN HAD BEEN A MEMBER OF SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL'S "S" BRANCH FROM 1940 TO 1945. MARTIN WAS ONE OF THE FIRST MEMBERS OF THE BRANCH, UNDER PROFESSOR FREDERICK LINDEMANN, LATER TO BE LORD CHERWELL. "S" BRANCH WAS TO ACT AS CHURCHILL'S PERSONAL INTELLIGENCE AND STATISTICAL SERVICE

The only true datum line is the two or three months following Dunkirk in 1940" Churchill goes on to ask for actual figures, comparisons and his own idea of being only 87% of the peak effort. - The final line of the letter being - "Do your best to find the solid truth". There are also some pencil annotations in the left hand border of the first page referring to 'Hansard'
